

On September 23, 1869, she married FIN-LEY PATTERSON COFFEY, the son of WELBORN COF-FEY and SALLIE COTTRELL. The Coffey family lived in the Mulberry community of Caldwell County. The Coffey's were originally from Ireland. They moved to England, then to Essex County, Va. It is believed they arrived in Virginia in 1690. FINLEY PATTERSON COFFEY's ancestry goes back to JOHN COFFEY who married JANE GRAVES. They had a son, THOMAS, born in Essex County, Va. on March 7, 1742. His family moved to Spotsylvania County, Va. and later to Albemarle County. THOMAS COFFEY married twice. First, ELIZABETH SMITH, by whom he had six children. ELIZABETH died and THOMAS married SALLY FIELDS. THOMAS, with his new wife and six children left Virginia and moved to Wilkes County, N. C. on the Yadkin River. There, six more children were born, including WILLIAM, grandfather of FINLEY PATTERSON COFFEY. WIL-

LIAM was born November 27, 1782, and died May 21, 1839. On October 18, 1804, WILLIAM COFFEY married ANNIE BOONE, daughter of ISRAEL BOONE and niece of DANIEL BOONE. WILLIAM and ANNIE had five children. Their second child, WEL-BORN, was the father of FINLEY PATTERSON COF-FEY. On January 2, 1832, WELBORN COFFEY married SALLIE COTTRELL. LUCIUS HAYWOOD, seventh child of ROBERT GAIUS TUTTLE and LUCINDA PUETT, was. born in Caldwell County on July 22, 1856. JAMES BUCHANAN was elected 'President that year. The Wabash and Erie Canal, 458 miles. long, which took 24 years to build, was opened the year that LUCIUS HAYWOOD was born. Harper's Weekly began publication that year. It's Never Too Late To Mend by Charles Reade and The Panarama by John Greenleaf Whittier were published in 1854, and "Darling Nelly Gray" and "Gentle Annie" were the popular songs of the day. The next year, 1857, the book The Impending Crisis of the South and How To Meet It by Hinton Rowan Helper, a North Carolina farmer, was published. LUCIUS HAYWOOD was only a boy of five years when the Civil War broke out in 1861.

As a young boy, LUCIUS HAYWOOD, or HAY-WOOD as he was called, went to a school located near the home of his uncle, BENEDICT MARCUS TUTTLE. While attending this school, HAYWOOD lived with his uncle "MARC". His uncle insisted that HAYWOOD help with the farm work, even though HAYWOOD's father was paying for his room and board. This farm work took time from HAYWOOD's studies and he resented it.

HAYWOOD went into the merchantile business as a young man. He had a store in Gamewell. He also operated a flour mill and a saw and shingle mill. These mills employed a lot of men. They were paid twenty-five cents per day. In 1889, HAYWOOD, with C.A. Little, started a tobacco factory. 23

Early in 1900 HAYWOOD moved his family into Lenoir in a "handsome new residence at Fairfield, opposite Mrs. Dr. Beall's." HAYWOOD had built this house. Two years later he sold the house but planned to build another one. He kept all his businesses going in Gamewell and his family spent the summers in Gamewell and the winters in town for a number of years.

In 1908, LUCIUS HAYWOOD was the Democrat candidate for the state legislature. A letter from the Democrat Executive Committee to the paper on October 23, 1908, states: "...The people in the county have for some time asked the Convention to nominate a country man and a farmer for the Legislature. They say they are tired of voting for lawyers and townsmen. Now it is up to them to make good, for the Democrat party has nominated a good, honest, country farmer and business man for that position. Mr. TUTTLE is a modern businessman, and has: made a success of all his undertakings, and will make us a good member in the next General Assembly, for he is going to be elected, and you will do well to cast your ballot for hims."
