The number to the right of the generation line, by the person, is that person's number. These numbers are arranged in order of birth, when known. That is, person number 1 is the oldest child. Person number 2 is the second oldest child, etc.

HUGH COFFEY, was born April 9, 1784, probably in Mecklenberg County, North Carolina. He died May 7, 1861, probably in Lafayette County, Mississippi, where he is likely buried. He married Margaret Walker, who was born October 1, 1789, and died November 4, 1854. Margaret was the daughter of Andrew Walker, who was born December 5, 1756 and died September 20, 1845, and his wife, Sarah (Cry) Walker, who was born March 25, 1757, and died November 7, 1793. There were at least three different Andrew Walkers in the North Carolina-South Carolina area. One Andrew Walker's Pension Claim Number was S-7839, received November 8, 1832, for service as Captain in the Revolutionary War. Some records indicate that the wife of Andrew Walker was Elizabeth Moore, who married Andrew in 1781, and that they had at least two daughters: Esther, born October 10, 1791, and died January 15, 1885. On March 12, 1812, Esther married Aaron Houston, who was born November 16, 1790, and died August 2, 1845. Their other daughter was Margaret Walker, who married Hugh Coffey.

HUGH COFFEY and Margaret (Walker) Coffey had at least eleven children: (1) Sarah Cry; (2) James M.; (3) John W.; (4) Harris; (5) ? N.; (6) Andrew B.; (7) Elizabeth W.; (8) Kaster L. (or Esther L.); (9) Sarah(?); (10) James A., and (11) Mary C. (The duplication of names is un-resolved at this time.

1. SARAH CRY COFFEY, was born July 29, 1807, and died June 29, 1826. She was never married.

3. JOHN W. (walker?) COFFEY, was born June 17, 1811, and died July 6, 1839. He married Lillie Beatty (or possibly Lillie Wilson. John Coffey is buried in the Pine Hill Cemetery, which is located 9 1/2 miles east of Oxford, Mississippi. They had at least one son: (1) John Beatty.

(2) 1. JOHN BEATTY COFFEY, was born ____ ? ____, and died September 5, 1864, in Howards Grove Hospital, Richmond, Virginia, from wounds received near Petersburg, Virginia.

(1) 4. HARRIS H. COFFEY, was born January 13, 1814, probably in Lancaster County, South Carolina, or Mecklenberg County, North Carolina. In 1836, Harris, with his parents, arrived in Lafayette County, Mississippi. On July 23, 1839, Harris married Martha Lambert, who was born January 12, 1824, in Henderson County, Tennessee. She was the daughter of A.J. Lambert (1800-1882). On October 11, 1859 (or 1858) Harris and Martha left Mississippi, for Sulphur Springs, Hopkins County, Texas. Here they ran a hotel at one time. Here Harris died January 30, 1874, and Martha died April 30, 1900. Harris is buried in the City Cemetery, at Sulphur Springs, where he has a cemetery marker. Harris and Martha had twelve children: (1) Elizabeth Francis; (2) Columbus Washington; (3) Margaret Rowena; (4) John Sebastian; (5) Benjamin Franklin; (6) Martha Clay; (7) Mary Tyler; (8) Henry Harris; (9) Nancy Sebella; (10) Eliza Lambert; (11) James Andrew, and (12) Robert Walker

About 1876 she married Josiah "Joe" H. Fain, who was born about 1836, in Missouri, and died _____. Joe had been married before, and had two children by the first marriage. Elizabeth and Joe had one child: (1) Logan.

She died November 27, 1894, when she, along with her youngest daughter, Kitty, were killed by a runaway horse. On February 25, 1862, in Hopkins County, Texas, she married Andrew Jackson "Jack" Bridges, who was born January 8, 1817, and died November 26, 1896. (One of the Coffey Family Bibles gives his date of death as October 24, 1897.) Both Sis Mag and Jack are buried in the City Cemetery, Sulphur Springs, Texas. Both have Cemetery Markers. Margaret Coffey was the second wife of Jack Bridges. He married, first, Mary Ann Pound, who died about 1861. Children of this marriage, if any, unknown. Andrew Jackson and Margaret (Coffey) Bridges had six children: (1) Henry Thomas; (2) Lee Flournoy; (3) Mary Margaret; (4) Martha Sarah; (5) John Dial, and (6) Kittie.

1. HENRY THOMAS BRIDGES, died in infancy.
2. LEE FLOURNOY BRIDGES, Sr., was born December 30, 1869, at Sulphur Springs, Texas, and died June 20, 1943. He was vice-president and professor of languages at Henry College (Methodist) located at Campbell, Hunt County, Texas.
