It is hoped that the arrangement of this Family History will be self-explanatory. The figures, shown thus: (1₁), indicates the Generation, with **JOHN COFFEY** being Generation No. 1, his children, as **JAMES COFFEY** Generation No. 2, etc. Thus, Elizabeth, John, Archelius, James, Jr., etc. would be Generation No. 2, their children Generation No. 3, etc. The numerals without any parenthesis, as 1, represent the number of the child, in that family. When known, the oldest child is No. 1, the next oldest, No. 2, etc. Thus, in the children of **JAMES COFFEY**, Elizabeth would be No. 1; John would be Child No. 2, etc.

Those persons who are of the direct **JAMES COFFEY** blood-line are shown in upper case, or **CAPITAL** letters. Spouses, step-children and foster children are shown in lower case letters.

Those names that are shown with an asterisk following the name, as **JOHN SMITH***, shows there is additional information on this person, shown in the appendix. This is usually an obituary, a marriage license, or other related information.

Any errors that may appear in this History are completely un-intentional, and I apologize. Any additional information or correction of any errors will be appreciated. Where known, the parents of a spouse, including mother's maiden name is included. Send any corrections or additional information to the compiler, and it will be included in future copies. The many blanks in the history are unknown facts, that would help to make the story more complete. Perhaps, eventually they will all be filled in.

Since this History is now on a computer, it is very easy to correct errors, or to add additional information.

**JAMES COFFEY AND HIS DESCENDENTS
IN WAYNE COUNTY, KENTUCKY**

(1) **JOHN COFFEY**, was born 16 July 1700, in Essex County, Virginia, and died January/February 1775, in Albermarle County, Virginia. He was the son of Edward and Ann (Powell) Coffey. He married Jane Graves, the daughter of John and Hannah Graves. John and Jane had seven children: (1) James; (2) William; (3) John; (4) Edmond (or Edward); (5) Winifred; (6) Thomas, and (7) Reuben. There was possibly also a Benjamin and Elizabeth.

1. **JAMES COFFEY**, was born 4 July 1729, in Essex County, or possibly Spottsylvania County, Virginia, and died September/October 1786, in Wilkes County, North Carolina. He was a Baptist minister. On 30 August 1750, he married Elizabeth Cleveland, who was born in February 1826, and died 1826/27, in Bedford County, Tennessee. Elizabeth was the daughter of Alexander Cleveland. James and Elizabeth had eleven children: (1) Elizabeth; (2) John; (3) Archelius; (4) James, Jr.; (5) Reuben B.; (6) Ambrose; (7) Ely; (8) Rice; (9) Martha; (10) Joel, and (11) Lewis Russell.

1. **ELIZABETH COFFEY**, was born in 1752, and died about 1811/12, probably in Wayne County, Kentucky. She married Robert Whitesides, who was born in 1738, and died in 1810. Robert and his wife owned land in Wayne County at one time, however they settled in the Nashville, Tennessee area. They had six children: (1) James; (2) Jonathan; (3) Mary; (4) William; (5) Joel, and (6) Lewis.

2. **JOHN COFFEY**, was born in 1753, and was never married. He was in the military service during the Revolutionary War.

3. **ARCHELAUS COFFEY**, was born about 1755, in Amherst County, Virginia, and died 27 December 1825 (doubtful date), in Wilkes County, North Carolina. (Some sources state that he died before 1786). He married Eleanor Wade, who was the daughter of John Wade. They had four children: (1) James; (2) John; (3) Hezekiah, and (4) Bailey.

1. **JAMES M. COFFEY**, was born 20 July 1776. He married Francis Lane.

2. **JOHN WAID COFFEY**, was born about 1778, and died before 1834. He married Mary "Polly" Harbord. They had at least two children: (1) Hezekiah and (2) Bailey. These two are sometimes shown as children of Archelaus, which is not supported by the records.

3. **JANE COFFEY**, was born 22 June 1782.

4. **JAMES COFFEY, JR.**, was born in 1755. He was unmarried. He moved to Wayne County, Kentucky, with the other members of the James Coffey family, in the early 1800s. He was dissatisfied with the country, and traded his land grant to Lewis Russel for a plot of land he had remaining in North Carolina, and returned to Wilkes County, North Carolina.

5. **REUBEN B. COFFEY**, was born 16 September (or 19 June) 1759, in Albermarle County, Virginia, and died 4 March 1842. In 1797 he lived in Wilkes County, North Carolina, on the North of Warrior Gap. From 1797 to 1818, he was in Burke County, North Carolina, at Blairs Fork. In 1819 he was in Wayne County, Kentucky, where he remained until his death 9 June 1842. He was in the Revolutionary War, and received a pension. He fought at the Battle of Kings Mountain, under Colonel Benjamin Cleveland, a first cousin. He is often confused with his Uncle Reuben. In 1782 he married Millie Morris. They had ten children: (1) Eleanor; (2) Sally; (3) Elizabeth; (4) James; (5) Anna; (6) Rachel; (7) Polly; (8) Oliver; (9) Austin, and (10) Naomi.

1. **ELEANOR COFFEY**, was born about 1783, in Wilkes County, North Carolina. She married Joel Hisan.

2. **SALLY COFFEY**, was born about 1785. She married Joseph Owens. They had at least one child: (1) Charles.

3. **ELIZABETH "Betsy" COFFEY**, was born about 1786, in Wilkes County, North Carolina. She married Thomas Sumpter, who died about 1843. They had six children: (1) Cathrine; (2) Jordan; (3) Polly; (4) Elizabeth; (5) Elenor, and (6) Thomas E.

- 1. **CATHRINE SUMPTER**, on 8 May 1834, she married James Selby.
- 2. **JORDAN SUMPTER**, was born about 1813, and died 1 December 1842. This death date is obviously in error, if the birthdates of his children are correct. On 4 April 1834 he married Mary "Polly" Overstreet, who was born in 1819. They had five children: (1) Charlotte J.; (2) John P.; (3) Henry T.; (4) Elizabeth F., and (5) Sefronia E.
 - 1. **CHARLOTTE J. SUMPTER**, was born in 1835.
 - 2. **JOHN P. SUMPTER**, was born in 1840.
 - 3. **HENRY T. SUMPTER**, was born in 1842.
 - 4. **ELIZABETH F. SUMPTER**, was born in 1844.
 - 5. **SEFRONIA E. SUMPTER**, was born in 1848.

- 4. **ELIZABETH SUMPTER**, was born in 1822.

- 6. **THOMAS E. SUMPTER**, was born in 1829. On 13 January 1855, he married Milly Matilda Gibson, who was born in 1833. They had at least two children: (1) William S., and (2) America Legrande.
 - 1. **WILLIAM S. SUMPTER**, was born 24 November 1855.
 - 2. **AMERICA LEGRANDE SUMPTER**, was born 28 November 1858. She married Rufus Abbott, who was born in 1833.
- 4. **JAMES "Old Jimmy" COFFEY**, was born in 1790, in Burke County, North Carolina, and died 22 February 1878. He was a farmer and a Baptist. He settled in Elk Spring Valley, Wayne County, Kentucky, where he took advantage of the Headright Act, after farming in that area. His land was in the mountains of Wayne, Pulaski and Whitley Counties, Kentucky. On 7 July 1810, in Burke County, North Carolina, he married Sarah "Sally" E. Sumpter, who was born about 1785, in North Carolina, and died 5 June 1885. Both are buried near Flat Rock, in the Old Flat Rock Cemetery, in Pulaski County, now McCreary County, Kentucky. They moved from North Carolina to Wayne County, Kentucky, about 1815, after the birth of their second child. They had ten children: (1) Nelson N.; (2) Lewis; (3) Elizabeth; (4) John; (5) Hardin; (6) James, Jr.; (7) Polly; (8) Reuben; (9) Joseph, and (10) Emaline.

1. **NELSON N. COFFEY**, was born 9 July 1811, in Burke County, North Carolina, and died 22 February 1878. He moved to Wayne County, about 1815, with his parents. He was a farmer and a Baptist. On 13/14 October 1830, in Wayne County, Kentucky, he married Kizziah Watters, who was born 10 March 1810, possibly in Tennessee, and died 5 June 1885, at the home of her son, Frank. Kizziah was the daughter of Elijah and Nancy (Rue/Rhue) Watters. Both Nelson and Kizziah are buried in the Coffey Cemetery, Wolf Creek, Daniel Boone National Forest, in Wayne (now McCreary) County, Kentucky. They lived near Burnside, Kentucky, according to the 1910 Census. They had eleven children: (1) Rhoda Ann;(2) Nancy; (3) James Nelson; (4) John; (5) Joseph;(6) Henry; (7) Richard Henderson; (8) Sarah; (9) Prudence A.; (10) Benjamin Franklin, and (11) Emmerine.

1. **RHODA ANN COFFEY**, was born 22 October 1831, possibly near Sumpter, Wayne County, Kentucky. She died 1 September 1920. In 1862, she married Lewis Perkins, who was born 30 December 1841, and died 14 May 1916. Both are buried in the Perkins Cemetery, Wolf Creek, Wayne County, Kentucky, now in the Daniel Boone National Forest. Lewis Perkins was a brother to Rev. James Perkins, who married Nancy Rue Coffey. Rhoda Ann and Lewis had six children: (1) Susanna J.; (2) Nelson;(3) John M.; (4) William; (5) Lou Vina, and (6) Rachel.

According to family tradition, Pleas was killed during the Civil War, and Nancy drew a pension on his service. On 6 January 1879, Nancy married, second, Tom Bell. Nancy is thought to be buried in the Nelson Coffey Cemetery, McCreary County, Kentucky.

3. **JAMES NELSON COFFEY**, was born 23 March 1835, at Coolidge, now in Whitley County, Kentucky, and died 20 February 1915. He was a farmer and a Baptist. On 9 May 1861, he married Sarah Margaret Barrier, who was born 14 January 1844, in Slavens, Wayne County, Kentucky, and died in 1932. Both are buried in the

Coffey-Ingram Cemetery, on their property. Sarah Margaret was the daughter of Richard "Dicky" and Permelia Ann (Lovell) Barrier. James and Sarah lived on Wolf Creek and Elk Spring/Oil Valley, Wayne County, Kentucky. They had twelve children:(1) Jane; (2) Nelson C.; (3) Richard; (4) Kizzie; (5) Amelia;(6) Henderson; (7) Prudence; (8) Adina; (9) Mary Malvina; (10) Nancy; (11) Burl, and (12) Susannah.

1. **JANE COFFEY**, was born 1 May 1862, at Wolf Creek, Wayne (now McCreary) County, Kentucky, and died 15 March 1927. On 15 January 1885, she married Lafayette "Fate" Emerson Foister, who was born 11 May 1863, in Wayne County, Kentucky, and died 21 April 1937. Fate was the son of Thomas and Martha A. (Dobbs) Foister. Both Fate and Jane are buried in the Coffey-Ingram Cemetery. They lived at Griffin, Oil Valley, Wayne County, Kentucky. They had three children: (1) Eva;(2) Martha, and (3) Granville.

1. **EVA FOISTER**, was born 25 March 1886, at Griffin, Wayne County, Kentucky, and died 28 November 1977. She married Abraham Lincoln Burks, who was born 22 March 1887, and died 29 April 1950.

2. **MARTHA FOISTER**, was born 27 May 1889, at Griffin, Wayne County, Kentucky, and died 24 February 1986 at the Midtown Nursing Home, Somerset, Kentucky. She is buried in the Elk Springs Cemetery. On 13 November 1950, she married as his second wife, Elmer Davenport, who was born in 1881, and died 29 May 1962. They lived on Columbia Avenue, Monticello, Kentucky.

3. **GRANVILLE FOISTER**, was born 20 July 1891, at Griffin, Wayne County, Kentucky, and died 10 October 1968, at Monticello, Kentucky. He is buried at Elk Springs. On 16 June 1916, he married Flonnie Huffaker, who was born 26 February 1900.

2. **NELSON C. COFFEY**, was born 11 (or 17) February 1864, at Wolf Creek, Wayne County, Kentucky, and died 1 May 1934. On 2 February 1887, in Wayne County, Kentucky, he married Sarah Emerine Worley, who was born 4 January 1867, near Freedom/Retner, and died 10 October 1957. She lived with her family in Jones Hollow, Kentucky. She was the daughter of Willis and Rachel (Jones) Worley. Both Nelson and Sarah are buried in the Coffey-Ingram Cemetery, Oil Valley, Wayne County, Kentucky. They had eight children: (1) Racheal (twin); (2) Emerine (twin); (3) James Nelson;(4) Albert (twin) (5) Wilburn (twin); (6) Alice; (7) Sarah, and (8) Kizzie.

1. **RACHEAL COFFEY**, was born in 1888, stillborn twin, buried in the Nelson Coffey Cemetery, Wolf Creek, Wayne (now McCreary) County, Kentucky.

3. **JAMES NELSON COFFEY**, was born 22 April 1889, in Wayne (now McCreary) County, Kentucky, and died 10 November 1977, at the Methodist Hospital, Indianapolis, Indiana. On 22 February 1911, at Monticello, Kentucky, he married Dica Ann Roberts, who was born 24 July 1894, and died 23 April 1962/63, in the Morgan County Hospital, Martinsville, Indiana. She was the daughter of Richard and Balzora (Bell) Roberts. James and Dica are buried in the Elk Spring Cemetery, Wayne County, Kentucky. They lived at Mooresville, Indiana. 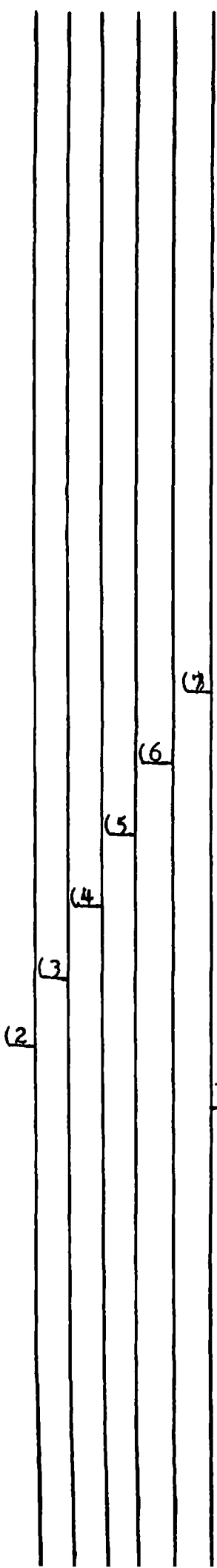

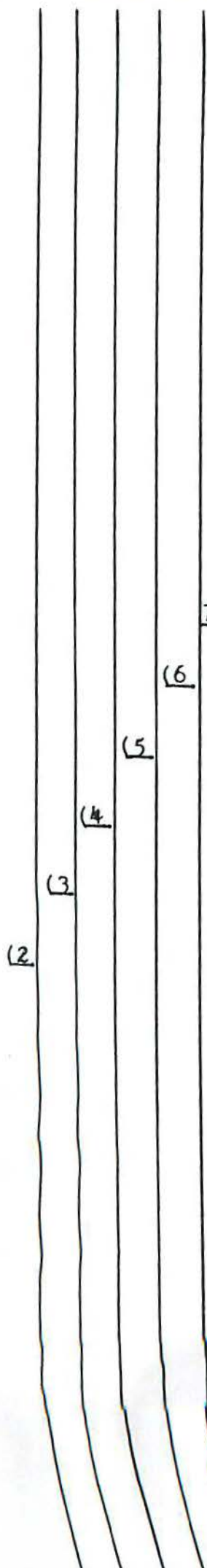
