## LINEAL DESCENT OF MAREEN DUVALL, THE FIRST EMIGRANT

I. MAREEN DUVALL, BORN 1625, DIED 1694 (PAGE 113, "VIRKUS",) CAME FROM FRANCE TO PROVINCE OF MARYLAND ABOUT 1650, HE SIRED 6 SONS AND 6 DAUGHTERS.

II.LEWIS DUVALL, BORN 1674, RECEIVED IN HIS FATHERS WILL THE "MIDDLE PLANTATION". REMOVED TO THE CAROLINAS IN 1710, MARRIED CA. 1699 TO MARTHA RIDGLEY. DAUGHTER OF ROBERT RIDGLEY. LEWIS DUVALL DIED IN S.C. IN 1724.

III. LEWIS DUVALL JR. BORN 1720, MARRIED AND RESIDED IN CRAVEN CO.N.C. LEFT A WILL THERE DATED 1792.

IV.LEWIS DUVALL III, RECEIVED A LAND GRANT ON WARRIOR CREEK IN 1767, BORN , MARRIED 1ST. TERESA BORN.? HE WAS IN LAURENS CO. AND GREENVILLE CO., S.C. FROM 1779 UNTIL CA 1802. TERESA DIED BY 1790 AND HE MARRIED 2ND. ELIZABETH (BETSY) BORN . SHE IS LISTED IN 1810 CENSUS OF LAURENS CO., AS BETSY DUVALL, WITH 1 M. UNDER 10, 2 F. 10-16, 2 F.16-26, 1 F. 45 & OVER. NO SLAVES. LEWIS DUVALL III, WENT TO ILL. AND PROBABLY KY. ABOUT 1802 AND DIED IN THE AMERICAN BOTTOM ABOUT 1808. HE RECEIVED OTHER LAND GRANTS IN LAURENS CO., S.C. AND ALSO IN ILL. CAPT. IN REVOLUTIONARY WAR.

V. JAMES DUVALL, BORN 1785 DIED IN LAURENS CO., IN 1853, MARRIED CA 1809 TO LETICIA HITCH, BORN 1785, DIED 1860. SHE WAS THE DAUGHTER OF LUTHER HITCH AND MARY NICHOLSON HITCH, LETICIA HAD 16 CHILDREN.

VI. JOHN W. DUVALL, BORN 1810 IN LAURENS CO., DIED 1864 ON DUVALL BRANCH IN MARSHALL COUNTY, AL. KILLED BY CARPET BAGGERS AT HIS HOME, BURIED IN HIS YARD BY FAMILY. HE WAS MARRIED TO RACHEL VEST BORN 1811. SHE DIED NEAR DECATUR, AL. MORGAN CO., SEVERAL YEARS LATER. INFO. BY ALVIE MILLARD TEAL BORN 6,8,1909, WHO LIVES ON ORIGIONAL DUVALL LAND IN PLESANT GROVE COMMUNITY, MARSHALL CL.

VII. JOHN LAWRENCE DUVALL, BORN 7/5/1838, DIED 8/29/1905.BURIED IN PLESANT GROVE CEMETARY IN MARSHALL CO. AL. MARRIED RACHEL MALINDA WILLIAMS OF BLOUNT CO. AL. IN 1861, WHO WAS BORN 3/20/1847 BLOUNT CO. DIED 1/9/1930. BURIED BY JOHN L. IN PLESANT GROVE CEMETARY. HER PARENTS; ALLEN YOUNG AND DOLLY (CORNELIOUS) WILLIAMS WHO ARE BURIED AT ROCK SPRINGS CHURCH CEMETARY IN MARSHALL CO. ALLENS NICKNAME: YOUNG BILL WILLIAMS: WHO DIED IN CIVIL WAR BATTLE AT FORT HENRY IN 1962: FORT HENRY WAS AT THE TENN./KY. STATE LINES.

VIII. JOHN WESLEY DUVALL, BORN 8/28/1862 DIED 5/27/1930 BURIED IN PLESANT GROVE CEMETARY, MARRIED BITHA JANE BONDS WHO WAS BORN 3/20/1861. DIED 7/4/1904. BURIED 3 MILES SOUTH OF PLESANT GROVE IN ROCK SPRINGS CEMETARY.???
