COFFEY

I - HUGH COFFEY (1700-1767)

A number of Coffeys (or Coffees) were among the Scotch-Irish who came to America and settled in Virginia, Maryland, Pennsylvania and the Carolinas. The earliest Coffey ancestor identified is Hugh Coffey who came to Virginia circa 1725, as a young man. He probably landed in Maryland and went from there to Harper's Ferry, Virginia, and from there to Augusta County, Virginia, a popular Scotch-Irish area. There are many references to him in Chalkey's 'Augusta County, Virginia Records' which indicate he lived on Cowpasture River, about 20 miles west of Lexington in the Shenandoah Valley. The name of his wife is not known. Some have suggested it may have been Mary Ramsey. It is believed that he had at least three sons:

Very little is known about the life of Hugh Coffey other than occasional legal documents which refer to him as an appraiser of land transactions. He died at his home or plantation on Cowpasture River circa 1767. On 22 August 1767, Augusta County property records show John Coffey, eldest son and heir of Hugh Coffey, deceased, and Susannah, of the Province of South Carolina, sold to John Ramsey for £40, 220 acres on Cowpasture River which had been patented on 3 November 1750 to Hugh Coffey, father of John.

II - JOHN COFFEY (1730-1800)

John Coffey was born circa 1730 in Augusta County, Virginia, where he grew up and married Susannah Watson. He owned land in Augusta County and later moved to Harper's Ferry and then to Lancaster County, South Carolina circa 1754.

He is frequently mentioned in the records of Lancaster County, Camden District, South Carolina, and owned land in the Waxhaws Settlement on Cane Creek, about six miles north of the town of Lancaster.

Both John and Susannah died circa 1800 and are probably buried in the old six-mile Church Graveyard in Lancaster County, South Carolina.

III - HUGH COFFEY (1750-1827)

Hugh Coffey was born 13 May 1750, near Harper's Ferry, Virginia. He moved with his parents to Lancaster County, South Carolina when he was four years old. He grew up in Lancaster County and married there Agnes Montgomery. Agnes was born 15 May 1755, the daughter of John Montgomery whose will is on file at Abbeville, South Carolina, dated 4 January 1777.

Hugh, along with his brothers, served in the Revolutionary War. Hugh served under his brother, Captain Henry Coffey, of Colonel Hampton's Regiment at Blackstock and was pensioned for his service.

Hugh owned land and lived in the same general vicinity as his father, John Coffey. Hugh died 26 April 1827 and his wife Agnes died 10 May 1838. They are probably buried in the old six-mile Church Graveyard in Lancaster County, South Carolina.

IV - JOHN COFFEY (1775-1816)

John Coffey was born circa 1775 in Lancaster County, South Carolina. He married circa 1794 Esther Givens, probably in the same County. Esther was born circa 1775 in North Carolina, probably Mecklenburg County, and was the daughter of William Givens who died there in 1798, and his wife, Jennet. They had the following children:

John died circa 1816 as the family was moving from South Carolina to Tennessee; however, the date and place of his death and burial are unknown. Esther is shown in the U. S. census for 1820 in Maury County, Tennessee, as head of household with her three sons. Her daughter Agnes 'Nancy' was married and living nearby.

In 1821, sons William G. and Hugh W. (both of Maury County, Tennessee) signed a power of attorney authorizing Henry Coffey (their uncle) of Lancaster District, South Carolina to represent them in the distribution of the estate of John Coffey (their father). This power of attorney was witnessed by James K. Polk, who later became the eleventh President of the United States.

A clipping found in an old Bible states:

The Coffey family of Maury County appears to have honored their father and mother with amazing reverence, judging from the following facts which reveal remarkable life tenure.

They were born in South Carolina and came to Tennessee in 1817, very poor and scarcely able to buy land, as cheap as it was then, settling near Campbell's Station, Maury County. Mrs. Caskey, the sister, lived in Giles County but now lives in Texas and is in her 88th year. William G. is in his 86th year, H. Wiley Coffey in his 84th year and S. W. Coffey in his 82nd year and as spry and active as many at 60. These four constitute the entire family, unbroken by the ruthless hand of death, and we doubt not that this case is without parallel. They were all born in the months of September and October, notwithstanding it is said that persons born between September and March attain greater age. They are all Democrats and never voted any other ticket.

Esther Coffey died in Maury County, Tennessee after 1850 and is believed to be buried in an unmarked grave in the Lasting Hope Cemetery.

V - AGNES 'NANCY' COFFEY (1795-1883)

Agnes 'Nancy' Coffey was born in 1795 in Lancaster County, South Carolina and married there 12 December 1811 Samuel Caskey. She died in Florence, Texas 23 November 1883, shortly after coming to Texas to visit, or to live with, two of her sons who had moved to Texas in 1851. She is buried in an unmarked grave in the Florence Cemetery.

These reflections by the mother of Billy Graham were obtained in an interview with 'Decision' a few months ago and are presented in this issue as a tribute to mothers everywhere. —ED

My father, Benjamin Morrow Coffey, had dark hair, penetrating brown eyes and a wonderful mind. During the Civil War he fought on the Confederate side, losing a leg at Gettysburg after being shot during Pickett's charge. For four hours he lay on that battlefield without receiving attention. As he was lying there a shell burst nearby and destroyed the sight of one eye.

To me my father didn't seem handicapped at all. But then, I was not born until nearly thirty years after Gettysburg. Our parents were farmers, and they reared us three girls in a Christian home. Father and Mother loved the Bible and literature. Every day they read the Bible to us and were diligent to teach us the meaning of the passages. I say this before the Lord as true, I cannot remember a day when I didn't
