It is hoped that the arrangement of this Family History will be self-explanatory. The figures, shown thus: (1\_, indicates the Generation, with JOHN COFFEY being Generation No. 1, his children, as JAMES COFFEY Generation No. 2, etc. Thus, Elizabeth, John, Archelius, James, Jr., etc. would be Generation No. 2, their children Generation No. 3, etc. The numerals without any parenthesis, as I. represent the number of the child, in that family. When known, the oldest child is No. 1, the next oldest, No. 2, etc. Thus, in the children of .JAMES COFFEY, Elizabeth would be No. 1; John would be Child No. 2, etc.

Those persons who are of the direct **JAMES COFFEY** blood-line are shown in upper case, or **CAPITAL** letters. Spouses, step-children and foster children are shown in lower case letters.

Those names that are shown with an asterisk following the name, as **JOHN SMITH\***, shows there is additional information on this person, shown in the appendix. This is usually an obituary, a marriage license, or other related information.

Where known, the parents of a spouse, including mother's maiden name is included. Send any corrections or additional information to the compiler, and it will be included in future copies. - 4. JAMES COFFEY, JR., was born in 1755. He was unmarried. He moved to Wayne County, Kentucky, with the other members of the James Coffey family, in the early 1800s. He was dissatisfied with the country, and traded his land grant to Lewis Russel for a plot of land he had remaining in North Carolina, and returned to Wilkes County, North Carolina.
- REUBEN B. COFFEY, was born 16 September (or 19 June) 1759,in Albermarle County, Virginia, and died 4 March 1842. In 1797 he lived in Wilkes County, North Carolina, on the North of Warrior Gap. From 1797 to 1818, he was in Burke County, North Carolina, at Blairs Fork. In 1819 he was in Wayne County, Kentucky, where he remained until his death 9 June 1842. He was in the Revolutionary War, and received a pension. He fought at the Battle of Kings Mountain, under Colonel Benjamin Cleveland, a first cousin. He is often confused with his Uncle Reuben. In 1782 he married Millie Morris. They had ten children: (1) Eleanor; (2) Sally; (3) Elizabeth; (4) James; (5) Anna; (6) Rachel; (7) Polly; (8) Oliver; (9) Austin, and (10) Naomi.
  - 1. ELEANOR COFFEY, was born about 1783, in Wilkes County, North Carolina. She married Joel Hisan.

He settled in Elk Spring Valley, Wayne County, Kentucky, where he took advantage of the Headright Act, after farming in that area. His land was in the mountains of Wayne, Pulaski and Whitley Counties, Kentucky. On 7 July 1810, in Burke County, North Carolina, he married Sarah "Sally" E. Sumpter, who was born about 1785, in North Carolina, and died 5 June 1885. Both are buried near Flat Rock, in the Old Flat Rock Cemetery, in Pulaski County, now McCreary County, Kentucky. They moved from North Carolina to Wayne County, Kentucky, about 1815, after the birth of their second child. They had ten children: (1) Nelson N.; (2) Lewis; (3) Elizabeth; (4) John; (5) Hardin; (6) James, Jr.; (7) Polly; (8) Reuben; (9) Joseph. and (10) Emaline.

NELSON N. COFFEY, was born 9 July 1811, in Burke County, North Carolina, and died 22 February 1878. He moved to Wayne County, about 1815, with his parents. He was a farmer and a Baptist. On 13/14 October 1830, in Wayne County, Kentucky, he married Kizziah Watters, who was born 10 March 1810, possibly in Tennessee, and died 5 June 1885, at the home of her son, Frank. Kizziah was the daughter of Elijah and Nancy (Rue/Rhue) Watters. Both Nelson and Kizziah are buried in the Coffey Cemetery, Wolf Creek, Daniel Boone National Forest, in Wayne (now McCreary) County, Kentucky. They lived near Burnside, Kentucky, according to the 1910 Census. They had eleven children: (1) Rhoda Ann;(2) Nancy; (3) James Nelson; (4) John; (5) Joseph; (6) Henry; (7) Richard Henderson; (8) Sarah; (9) Prudence A.; (10) Benjamin Franklin, and (11) Emmerine.

RHODA ANN COFFEY, was born 22 October 1831, possibly near Sumpter, Wayne County, Kentucky. She died 1 September 1920. In 1862, she married Lewis Perkins, who was born 30 December 1841, and died 14 May 1916. Both are buried in the Perkins Cemetery, Wolf Creek, Wayne County, Kentucky, now in the Daniel Boone National Forest. Lewis Perkins was a brother to Rev. James Perkins, who married Nancy Rue Coffey. Rhoda Ann and Lewis had six children: (1) Susanna J.; (2) Nelson;(3) John M.; (4) William; (5) Lou Vina, and (6) Rachel.

- JAMES NELSON COFFEY, was born 23 March 1835, at Coolidge, now in Whitley County, Kentucky, and died 20 February 1915. He was a farmer and a Baptist. On 9 May 1861, he married Sarah Margaret Barrier, who was born 14 January 1844, in Slavens, Wayne County, Kentucky, and died in 1932. Both are buried in the
