Following is the will of Joshua Coffee:

In the name of God, Amen. I, Joshua Coffee, being in a low, weak and sickly state of body but od sound mind and memory, blessed be God, do on this first day of September in the year of our Lord Christ Jesus, one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, make and constitute this my last will and testament.

First, I do commit my soul to God, who gave it and my body to be buried in a Christian and decent manner and as to my goods and affairs of this world, I do will and devise that they be distributed and disposed of in the manner and form following.

First, my will is that all my just and lawful debts be paid.

Secondly, I do give and bequeath to my loving son, John Coffee, the first choice of five slaves to be disposed of for the purpose of procuring land that my loving wife, Elizabeth, shall enjoy the land so procured during her natural life. After the decease of my wife the land procured as afore

mentioned shall be vested in my son, and his heirs forever.

Thirdly, on Mr. Harris, my son-inlaw, returning such property to my
estate as he had received, that, then
the whole estate remaining shall be
equally divided and distributed between
my loving wife, Elizabeth, and my two
children, John Coffee and Polly (Mary)
Harris, and after the decease of my
wife Elizabeth, my will and desire is
that such parts of the estate that I
now will to my wife Elizabeth shall be
equally divided between my two children,
John Coffee and Polly (Mary) Harris.

And lastly, I do constitute and appoint my loving wife, and my son, John Coffee, sole executors of this my last will and testament in trust to execute according to the true literal interest and meaning thereof, in testimony whereof, I do here set my hand and seal, date above written. COFFEE FAMILY

In an introduction to an article. "Letters of Gen. John Coffee to his wife (1815 - 1816)", published in the Tennessee Historical Magazine Dec.. 1916, Judge DeWitt gives interesting genealogical data of the Coffee family which refers to Joshua Coffee as follows: Gen. John Coffee was born in Prince Edward County, Va., June 2. 1772 and died on his plantation "Hickory Hill" on Cox's Creek, near Florence. Ala., July 7. 1833. His father, Joshua Coffee (1745 - 1797) removed in 1775 from Virginia to Granville Co.. N. C. and became in 1780 a Captain in the Granville Regiment of militia. For 9 months he saw service toward the South in the Revolutionary militia. At the close of the Revolution, he removed to Rockingham Co., N. C., where he died in 1797. He left a widow, Elizabth Graves Coffee (1751 - 1804) and three children, Thomas Graves Coffee, John Coffee and Mary Coffee, who married Simpson Harris. The elder son became a resident of Alabama and the two younger children removed to Tennessee.

It was in April 1798, that John Coffee came with his mother to the village of Maysborough on the Cumberland River near the present village of Madison, a few miles above Nashville. He married in 1807, Mary, daughter of John Donelson and their children were Mary Donelson, John Donelson, Elizabeth Graves and Joshua Coffee. This son Joshua Coffee was born in 1832 and died in 1879. In the old North Carolina records is an interesting record in which Joshua Coffee is mentioned as having been in a list of 27 who sold horses, one bay horse, 6 years old. 4 ft. 10 size: \$333 2-3 bad dollars; brand DC., N. C. delivered to Major Barnwell.

I have been given the opportunity of adding to THE COFFEE FAMILY, Descendents of Peter and Susannah Coffee in the Thomas Graves Coffee and Mary Knight Coffee Line, compiled by the late Mr. J. J. Haley of Gadsden, Alabama.

my contribution concerns the descendents of Catherine Jackson, grand daughter of Thomas Graves Coffee and daughter of Elizabeth (Betsy) Coffee. I have collected many descendents of Catherine (Jackson) Bulls and Dempsey Bulls. All records are complete to 1960 with the exception of the descendents of James H. Bulls who was the son of Catherine and Dempsey Bulls, and the descendents of Phillip whitehead of Alabama who was the grandson of Dempsey and Catherine Bulls, In the material added to this work, for the sake of brevity, I have included only those family members through the great grand children of Dempsey and Catherine.

Since the ancestors of Thomas Graves Coffee and Mary Knight are as colorful as a parade through Colonial Williamsport. I am giving some brief items that, I believe, should fascinate any person who claim these persons as progenitors.

Mrs. Charles McDougal (Kate Coffee) born at Florence, Alabama June 15, 1842, was a great grand daughter of Captain Joshua Coffee of North Carolina and Elizabeth Graves Coffee. Kate (Coffee) mcDougal was a grand daughter of General John Coffee of Tennessee who gained historical Tame as a great cavalry leader in the Battle of New Orleans during the war of 1812.

This same General John Coffee was a younger brother of our own Thomas. Mrs. Kate McDougal gives the GRAVES lineage in ABRIDGED COMPENDIUM OF AMERICAN GENEALOGY, First Families of America, published by Virkus in 1925. In Volume I, page 185 her line reads:

Lyon Gardiner Tyler edited NARRATIVES OF EARLY VIRGINIA, 1606-1625 in 1925. On Page 159 in a list of names of those coming with the Second Supply in 1608 is this entry:

Thomas Graves, Gentleman

Jester and Hiden published, in 1926
ADVENTURERS OF PURSE AND PERSON. The
GRAVES family history is given on pages
188-193. In this work an interesting
account is given of the capture of
Captain Thomas Graves by the Indians
shortly after his arrival in the colony.
He was rescued from Opechacanough's town
by Thomas Savage, a protege of Powhatan.
Opechacanough was a brother of Powhatan,
and an uncle of Pocahontas.

The rescue of Capt. Graves caused quite a furor among the different tribes of Indians, and was a matter of concern in the Colony. Opechacanough never recovered from the hatred that was a direct result of this event. It was one of the underlying causes of the massacres led by the Indian in both 1621/22, and 1644.

In an edition of SMITH'S GENERAL HIST-ORIE, BOOK IV, Page 354, Captain John Smith describes the rescue by Savage of Captain Thomas Graves.

The laughing Kings on the Easterne Shore told us that Opechacanough had imployed Onianimo to kill Salvage; because he brough the trade from him (Opechacanough) to the Easterne Shore, and some disgrace hee had done his sonne and some thirteene of his people before one hundred of those Easterlings, in rescuing Thomas Graves, whom they would have slaine; where he and three more did challenge the thirteene Pamunkies to fight, but they durst not; so that all those Easterlings so deride them that they came there no more.

Further data from Jester and Hiden states that Captain Graves was representative from Smythe's Hundred to the first Representative Legislative Assembly in Jamestown in 1619. He lived at Accomac, was addressed as Esquire, was commissioner, was Burgess to the Assembly in 1629-30, and was a member of the first vestry of the Farish in 1635. He died late in 1635 or early in 1636. His wife was named Katherine.

MARY KNIGHT, wife of Thomas Graves Coffee, was descended from the WOODSON family of the First Families of Virginia. In ABRIDGED COMPENDIUM OF AMERICAN GENEALOGY, by Virkus, page 175 is this lineage:

Thomas Graves Coffee

According to Jester and Hiden in ADVENTURERS OF PURSE AND PERSON, 1607-1625:

John Woodson and his wife Sarah came to Virginia in 1619 in the GEORGE and settled at Flowerdew Hundred. Aming accepted but unverified data John Woodson was a physician, and was killed during the Indian massacre of 1644. Sarah saved her two sons by hiding one under a tub and the other in a potato hole.

Due to loss of records, there is no documentary evidence linking Dr. John Woodson to Robert Woodson born 1624 in Virginia. Hiden states:

The family records with no evidence to the contrary presented during the subsequent seventeen decades has posited this accepted descent. curtains of the past and give a brief glimpse into the lives of our ancestors. These dramatic events have helped mold your character. The pages of history and the shelves of county officials throughout the country hold many such records of these and other progenitors of your family. They can be discovered by any person who finds his own family history fascinating. I hope that some descendent with a spark for preserving his own story for posterity will be inspired to follow this family back to the immigrant ancestor, and compile in written form



Will of PETER COFFEE

In the name of God Amen, this thirty first day of January 1771. I, Peter Coffee, of the County of Prince Edward, and the Parish of St. Patrick, being in a very sick and low condition, but of perfect mind and memory, Blessed be to God for his mercies toward me, and calling to mind the uncertainities of this transitory life, and knowing that all flesh must yield unto death whenever it shall please God to call, do make and ordain, constitute and appoint, this, my last will and Testament, in manner and form following:

First, I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God my Saviour and Redeamer, nothing doubting but what I shall receive the same again with joy and gladness by the mighty power of God at the general Resurrection. My body I commit to the earth from which it was taken to be buried in a decent Christian like manner at the discretion of my executors hereafter named. And, as touching my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God far above my desserts to bestow upon me, I do give and dispose of the same in manner and form following:

ITEM: I will that all those debts which I in justice owe to any person or persons whatever be paid as soon as conveniently they can after my decease by my executors.

ITEM: I do lend unto my beloved wife, Susanna Coffee, the land and plantation

whereon I now live, together with the several stock of horses, cattle, hogs and sheep now belonging to me, and other movable effects, during her widowhood or well-managing of the same, but in case she should prove "cearless or waistfull" of the said Effects, then my executors, hereafter named, to dispose of the said Effects as they shall think proper for the benefit of my surviving children, notwithstanding the Legacies which I shall hereafter mention, I will that she shall pay as she in her discretion shall think proper to the Legatees hereafter mentioned.

ITEM: I give to my son, William Coffee, one hundred and fifty acres of land lying on Vaughan's Creek in the County aforesaid, to be laid off agreeable and with the course now begun and to run for complement and being the same tract he has already obtained a deed for, only with some additional alterations.

ITEM: I give to my son Peter Coffee five shillings sterling.
ITEM: I give to my son Joshua Coffee five shillings sterling.

ITEM: I give to my daughter Catharina Thomas five shillings sterling.

ITEM: I give to my daughter Mary <u>Kindal</u> (or <u>Hindal</u>) five shillings sterling.

ITEM: I give to my daughter Hannah Weakley ten pounds at my daughter Bettie's death.

ITEM: I give to my daughter Lydia Coffee fifteen pounds current money at my daughter Bettie's death.

Coffee the land and plantation whereon I now live at her mother's decease during her natural life, and at her decease to be sold and all my legacies paid therewith, both those before mentioned and those I shall hereafter mention, and if there is anything remaining after the sale of said land and movables at my wife's and daughter's decease such sum to be equallly divided amongst all my grandchildren then living, and I appoint my wife and son William Coffee to be executor and executrix of this my Will ratifying this and none else to be my last Will and Testament. utterly disannulling all other wills and bequests by me heretofore made.

ITEM: I give to my daughter Elizabeth

Dempsey Deans Bulls married Catherine Jackson

Note: I can find no documentary evidence that Catherine is the daughter of Stewart Jackson and Elizabeth Woodson Coffee, but she was a WOODSON-COFFEE daughter. I have felt for several months that she was theirs. The material on page 10 of J. J. Haley's work which precedes this says that the wife of Dempsey Bulls was the daughter of Betsy Coffee and Thomas Jackson. Possibly the name by which this Jackson was known was Thomas. The family has always known they were related to these Coffees some way. They have known they were related to the Crittendens, and there are pictures of Anna Borah in family belongings. Julia Jackson Gillespie wrote a letter to the daughter of Dempsey Bulls signing herself. "Your affectionate aunt." I presume this to be the correct family tie, and am preparing these family sheets claiming such to be fact. Should anyone reading this know of proof for this. notify me.

Minnie O. Bulls (Mrs. Howard L. Bulls) P. O. Box 542 Reedley, California CATHERINE CASSANDRA DELVINA AMANDA WOODSON JACKSON, daughter of Stewart Jackson and Elizabeth Woodson (Betsy) COFFEE, married DEMPSEY DEANS BULLS, son of Barnabas Bulls and Elizabeth Deans, near Center Star Alabama, Jan. 7, 1834.

Dempsey Bulls was orphaned early in life. He was reared by his grandfather. Dempsey Deans, an early settler in Lauderdale County, Alabama. Oscar and Bryant Deans of Rogersville are descendants of this Dempsey Deans. Both Dempsey and Catherine were born about 1814, he in North Carolina, and Virginia was her birth place. They owned a sawrill and grist rill on Blue Water. It was here that their 10 children were born. In 1863 two of their sons died of measles in a Confederate Camp. Within six weeks the death of John Bulls and Junious R. Bulls, Catherine died of a broken heart. She died March 27, 1863. Dempsey Bulls died at the home of his son Frank, May 4, 1874.
